"Embassy of Musical Mastery" will come to Bangladesh

May 7 and 8, 6 pm. For the first time the Saint-Petersburg Music House will introduce its concerts from the "Embassy of Musical Mastery" series in Dhaka. The young talented soloists, prize-winners of the international competitions, Alexey Morozov, flute and Nikolay Saratovskiy, piano will give a concert dedicated to the Victory Day in the Russian Embassy in Dhaka.

The Bangladesh audience will be offered a rich program combining famous masterpieces of the recognized Russian and European classics. Music lovers will hear excerpts of 'Suite in E Major' by Bach, the Symphony No.6 and 'Eugene Onegin' by Tchaikovsky. Folk motives will be shown in 'Pictures at an Exhibition' by Mussorgsky and 'Spanish Rhapsody' by Liszt. The musicians will play the frequently performed works by **Rachmaninoff** such as Vocalise, the fifth and the twelfth Preludes as well as romantic Dedication by Schumann, virtuosic Introduction and Rondo Capriccioso by Saint-Saens, famous Sonatine for Flute and Piano by Dutilleux and fantastic sonata 'Undine' by Reinecke.

Alexey Morozov (28 years old). Graduate of the Gnessins Russian Academy of Music. Gold medalist of the Youth Delphic Games of Russia (Yaroslavl, 2007), prize winner at the Vladimir Tsybin International Flute Competition (Moscow, 2007) and "UNISA competition" (RSA, 2014).

Nikolay Saratovskiy (27 years old). Graduate of the Moscow Conservatory. Prize-winner at the International Piano Competition in Taranto (Italy, 2013), prize-winner at the International Piano Competition in Madrid (Spain, 2013). Prize winner and audience award winner at the "Arcangelo Speranza" International Competition in Taranto (Italy).
