## "Embassy of Musical Mastery" will come to Israel

<u>On May 30, Saturday, at 2pm</u>, the Saint-Petersburg Music House and Rossotrudnichestvo invite you to a concert from "Embassy of Musical Mastery" cycle in the Jerusalem International Center where the laureates of international competitions Vitaliy Vatulya (saxophone) and Filipp Kopachevskiy (piano) will perform within the Israel Musical Festival. The Israel tour of "Embassy of Musical Mastery" will continue on May 31 with a performance of the Music House soloists in the Russian Cultural Center in Tel-Aviv.

Vitaliy Vatulya will play Concerto Capriccio by **Grigoriy Kalinkovich**. This composition on Paganini themes enables the soloist to demonstrate all capabilities of his instrument. Furthermore, the unique lyric and dramatic Sonata by Brahms which was created initially for clarinet but then arranged for alto saxophone will feature.

The music lovers will also have a chance to enjoy **Ravel's Noble and Sentimental Waltzes** performed by Filipp Kopachevskiy. The great composer whose 140<sup>th</sup> anniversary is celebrated this year was inspired for the Waltzes creation by Schubert's works. For the 175<sup>th</sup> anniversary of **Tchaikovsky**, the musical pieces from 'The Seasons' which is the most often played piano cycle will be performed; the lyrical mood will be kept up ty **Chopin**'s Waltzes which are known as "musical poetry" and Polonaise, composer's respect to his dear Poland.

In the Russian Cultural Center in **Tel Aviv**, the guests will hear a special piano program in which the Ravel's Waltzes will be combined with Brahms musical works: romantic fantasies and virtuoso Hungarian Dances.
