"Ambassadors of Musical Mastery" will perform in Beijing on the 70th anniversary of the Victory

<u>On August 6 and 7, Thursday and Friday</u>, the St. Petersburg Music House and "Rossotrudnichestvo" present concerts of the "Embassy of Musical Mastery" project that will be held in China for the first time. The laureates of international competitions Tatiana Starkova (soprano) and Vladimir Gudozhnikov (bass-baritone) will perform in the Russian Cultural Center in Beijing and in the Kaisin Concert Hall on the 70th anniversary of the Great Victory. The piano part will be performed by the laureate of international competitions Anatolii Kuznetsov.

Selections from the folk drama **"The Enchantress"** and the first-of-its-kind lyric opera **"Eugene Onegin"** will be performed in the year of the 175th anniversary of **Tchaikovsky**. Slavic themes will be continued by an aria from the fantastic **"Christmas Eve"** by **Rimsky-Korsakov** and Cavatina from **"Aleko"**, the **Rachmaninov's** first opera. The following European opera "hits" will be performed for the audience: **"II Trovatore" by Giuseppe Verdi, "Faust" by Charles Gounod** and **"Carmen" by Georges Bizet**. The singers will also perform songs by **Rachmaninov, Tchaikovsky**, and **Glinka**. The war lyrics - songs to music by **Mark Fradkin, Kirill Molchanov, Ian Frenkel** and **Matvey Blanter** – will be performed for the Chinese listeners in the year of the 70th anniversary of the Great Victory.

The winner of the Rimsky-Korsakov International Competition (2015). A soloist of the Academy of Young Opera Singers of the Mariinsky Theatre.

Vladimir Gudozhnikov (28 years old). Was born in Aktobe (Kazakhstan). A graduate from the N.A. Rimsky-Korsakov St. Petersburg Conservatory (the class of Olga Kondina, the People's Artist of Russia). A vocal artist of the Saint-Petersburg Philharmonic.
