From Northern Capital to China. "Embassy of Musical Mastery" concert to take place in Beijing

November 18, Wednesday, 7 pm Saint Petersburg Music House and Rossotrudnichestvo invite listeners to Russian Cultural Center in Beijing, where the Embassy of Musical Mastery is to arrive again with laureates of international contests Aleksandr Petrov (flute) and Alexander Kashpurin (piano) due to perform.

A true musical palette awaits the audience on that evening: from romanticists to the 20th century. Melodies from the romanticism epoch will sound: Withered Flowers song from Schubert's "The Fair Maid of the Mill" cycle, Chopin's Impromptus and Scriabin's Sonatas. The music of the 20th century will be represented by Sonata №3 by Prokofiev "From the Old Notebooks" and popular aria for the flute and piano by a Georgian composer Otar Taktakishvili. The Russian folk motives will sound in the Variations by Nikolay Platonov on the theme of Red Pinafore Dress. In honor of Pyotr Tchaikovsky's 175th anniversary, his works will be performed, including Lensky's Aria from the opera Eugene Onegin and Sentimental Waltz.

Alexander Petrov (age 22). Born in Luga City, Leningrad Oblast. Student of Saint Petersburg Conservatory (class of Distinguished Artist of the RF professor Olga Chernyadyeva). Winner of the Silver Tuning Fork International Competition (2009) and Window to Europe Festival Competition (2010). Participant of the Music House programs since 2012.

Alexander Kashpurin (age 18). Born in Volzhsky city, Volgograd Oblast. Student at Saint Petersburg Conservatory (class of Distinguished Artist of the RF professor Tatyana Zagorovskaya). Winner of the Russia's Young Talents National Contest (Moscow, 2011), Modern Classics International Contest (Latvia, 2012) and Chopin Golden Ring International Contest (Slovenia, 2013). Participant of the Music House programs since 2013.
